5. Finance

All the employees that were furloughed have now returned to work and all the job retention scheme refunds have been received. For the period 16/9/20 to 15/10/20 the total income including Gift Aid was £18739. Expenditure including capital expenditure was £21321. Interest free loan outstanding £97,000

The appeal for contributions for the estimated IT equipment cost of £15000 has raised £10519.

The annual accounts to 31 March 2020 have been sent to the members for approval. The buildings insurance has been renewed for a further year.

6. Communion

It is proposed to have communion and prayer on the first Wednesday of each month. Will be on Zoom. The new cameras will allow the service to be held in the church. The first communion service will be on Wednesday 4th November.
